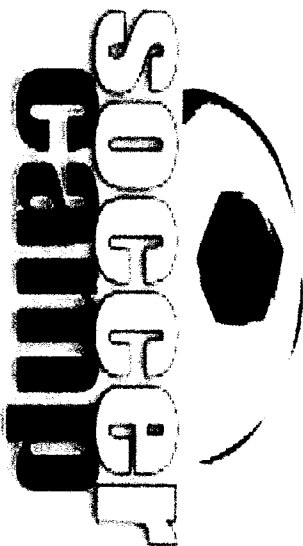

The PAYS MPS/MCU Phoenix Summer Soccer Camp has again assembled a very strong staff of local and regional coaches. Our **camp directors**, Falmouth High School Varsity Boys' head coach, **Dave Haligan** (2009 NSCAA New England Coach of the Year & 1999 NSCAA National Coach of the Year) and Yarmouth High School Varsity Boys' head coach, **Mike Hagerly** (2008 NSCAA New England Coach of the Year) have combined for over 575 career victories, 26 Western Maine Championships and 19 Maine State Titles.
